Leslie Ford and Tom Bialozor from Columbia Pacific CCO updated us on Behavioral Health services in our region, which CPCCO oversees as of June 1<sup>st</sup>. The CCCO 2.0 focus is on integration of health services, with a greater emphasis on social determinants of health, and outcomes in those areas. The priority is the continuity of care for our members. There is now one number to call for ALL health needs, to avoid confusion and access issues. There will soon be care coordination teams to serve members telephonically or in person for all healthcare. An opioid treatment program will be opening soon in Seaside; people can self-refer. Potential providers can go to our website or call member services. OHP and Me will hopefully be rolling out in January to further communicate with our members. In addition, a new E-Z Guide is in production which will contain the new behavioral health info. Leslie and Tom are encouraged to provide updates in January.

**New Business/Announcements:** There will be no December meeting; the CCO will be meeting with individual members and doing 2020 planning based on CCO 2.0 changes and requirements.
