Clatsop County Community Advisory Council Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 5:02 by Chair. Minutes and agenda were approved. Clatsop County Public Health was unable to join us, so we skipped this item.

IA Update: Over half of U.S. states are experiencing a COVID19 surge, including record high numbers in Oregon. Phase 3 won't happen until the end of September. Mandatory masks are in effect in seven counties starting tomorrow, and the other counties have the option to request the same. Schools are the most common reporters of child abuse, resulting in a lack of reporting. The state is looking at ways to look out for kids who may be in compromised homes.

Discussed effective recruitment strategies such as radio and social media. The CCO has published an annual report, which will be sent to the CAC.

SOAR: Reviewed the Aspirations statement for the SOAR; Romy will send that out to the CAC.

New Business/Announcements: CCA has received \$612,000 in COVID funding for housing; income qualifications for the funding have become more generous. CCA's COVID-related materials are now in Spanish. We will have one 1½ hour meeting per month, starting in July. Meetings will stay online for foreseeable future due to COVID.
