Chair called the meeting to order, and the group was introduced to Angel Escobedo, a new CCO staff who is developing trauma informed networks for Clatsop and Columbia Counties. Romy Carver is filling in for Sarah Brown until the vacancy is filled and will be taking notes, sending out agendas, etc.

Nancy Knopf updated the group on results from the Story Collection project. There will be a rollout on January 30 at 4:30pm in the Seaside Public Library. We will schedule local 1-hour presentations to partners during February; the group provided suggestions. Nancy will get fliers approved and we will get them out to the CAC. After presentation, the CAC will vote on priorities and then it will go to the Regional CAC. Recommendation then goes to the board.

Joell Archibald updated Council on CCO 2.0, which is the biggest procurement ever in Oregon. She also gave information on the annual CAC Conference, to be held March 19-20. This year, all CAC members are welcome. More information will be sent via email. As part of the OHA discussion, it was suggested that at the March meeting we navigate the OHA Transformation Center website. DHS and OHA have created new positions, which will be integrated eligibility workers.

The Advisory Council then discussed plans for the next few months: Deep dive into the info on the story collection presented by Ari Wagner on January 30, annual meeting and OHA website navigation, aging/depression, encourage CWIF grant requests to support resilience and build social skills, regional CHIP.
