# Summary of Minutes December 2017 Columbia County Community Advisory Council

The meeting opened at 3:30pm and the agenda was reviewed.

The minutes from November meeting were approved.

## **Incentive Metrics Projects Update:**

**PowerClean** – Third cohort began with 27 participants. Some issues with data collection have been reported and needs to be reviewed. The PowerClean concept will be presented at the Opioid Summit and the Peerpocalypse Conference this spring and the data supporting this project is needed. There are plans currently being made for the next cohort to be youth who are court affiliated or are part of the Systems of Care services.

**Motivational Interviewing** – Practice group starting soon.

**Welcome Home** – On hold for now.

**Paper Tigers and Resilience Screenings** – 56 community members attended a recent screening of Resilience, followed by a good conversation. More showings will be scheduled. NWESD discussed the grant they received that will expand ACEs learning/training to classified staff (custodians, bus drivers, etc.).

#### CAC SWOT Analysis:

The CAC was lead through a SWOT analysis where advisory council members identified areas of strengths and opportunities to look at changing some of the CAC agenda process(s).

### <u>Innovator Agent update</u>:

Joell gave an overview of her role with the State and the CCO. She mentioned OHA has created a short, three to four-minute video describing what/how a CCO works and would be interested in the CAC feedback. She mentioned that 211referral service can be accessed by a mobile app. See her IA report for the link. Work to finalize the 2017 Quality Pool is underway, more to come.

## Other Updates:

**Community Paramedicine** – An offer has been made and accepted for the position and the person starts on December 18<sup>th</sup>. If, available, the person will be invited to attend the January CAC meeting.

**Resilience** – More community showings are being scheduled for 2018 and Shaunee is working on a tool kit for community members to use if they want to host showings.

**DV/Prevention Program** – Starting in Scappoose school. New prevention specialist will be leading this work.
