- Patient-centered care and other access improvements.

How is Columbia Pacific Coordinated Care Organization transforming health care?

- We integrate dental, behavioral and physical health care together. That means patients will know all their providers are working together, using the same information about treatment and prescriptions.



- With patient-centered primary care medical homes, all patients, not just Oregon Health Plan members, benefit from team care.
- Through community needs assessments, we're learning what we need to do to make our communities the healthiest places to live, work and play.
- We're taking a community-wide look at pain management to address addictions and unplanned care that result in emergency care.
