

The Advisory Council approved the minutes as submitted, as well as the agenda.

The Advisory Council received an update on the Incentive Fund Project, Healthy Hearts.

Currently the Coordinator is working more fluidly with the clinics and Medical Assistants to better measure the success of the program. The Coordinator reported multiple events, including local nutrition lessons and visits from the Providence Dietician.

The Council had a brief discussion about other areas of concern in the community; particularly the lack of access to Public Health in South Clatsop County.

The quarterly theme for the Clatsop Community Advisory Council is homelessness and access to affordable housing throughout the county. The discussion continued by recapping the Project Homeless Connect event that Clatsop Community Action (CCA) hosted in January. It was reported that the event was less attended that years prior, and an element to why that may be is because the weather was good that day. Elaine Bruce, Executive Director of CCA said that it is a trend nationwide when the weather is worse, that attendance is better at events like this. The Council continued in discussion about other elements of housing that are being addressed in Clatsop County through various agencies.

The Advisory Council received the Resource Directory created by CCA. This directory outlines the agencies and resources available in Clatsop County. It is also accessible online at ccaservices.org.

The Council with an update to the incentive fund measures; with a few changes, additions and subtractions. Those were made available to members in print form.

The Advisory Council Members participated in rapid feedback evaluation of the new framework, which will be evaluated outside of the regular meeting.
