AGENDA ITEMS:

Meeting called to order at 1:03pm. Started interpretation, agenda and minutes were approved.

CAC Learning Theme: Teresa shared a video about intersectionality, and we discussed how intersectionality impacts health.

CWIF volunteer request: Heather requested volunteers to review CWIF applications.

Regional Health Assessment Update: Heather shared that we have collected 959 stories so far during Story Collection, about 350 from Tillamook County. We will be doing community presentations of our findings to hear the priorities in October.

CWIF Volunteers: Heather put out an appeal for CAC members to volunteer to review CWIF applications.

Oregon Law Center: Holly Pennock gave an overview of services available through the Oregon Law Center (OLC). Their focus is on equity-based justice and integrity. They help with employment, housing, public benefits, family law, seniors, civil rights, immigration, education, and consumer law. Large Grant Proposal: Peter Starkey from Folktime is requesting a Letter of Support from the CAC for a Large Grant, in partnership with OUR Tillamook and CARE, to strengthen the Traditional Health Worker network in Tillamook County. The CAC voted to approve a Letter of Support contingent upon the grant funding including designated clerical support for credential and other participant documents, and that grant funds be part of the annual audit (not co-mingled).
