AGENDA ITEMS:

Meeting called to order at 1:02pm by Co-Chair. Started interpretation, agenda and minutes were approved. Went through housekeeping slides for virtual meetings and interpretation. Voted in our new member!

CAC Learning Theme: Teresa introduced Reyna Gillet and Rebekah Markillie, who shared information about Residents Organizing for Change, which started in 2019. ROC is a network to join voices to positively impact housing, through sharing personal stories and lived experience, as well as talking to legislators.

CWIF: Nancy shared the four CAC applications for Tillamook County and the reviewers gave their feedback. Applications included Tillamook Early Learning Center, Habitat for Humanity, Tillamook Food Pantry, and Adventist Community Services. This led to a discussion about access issues to food banks, especially transportation.

Regional Health Assessment Update: Heather reports that we have exceeded our goal for Story Collection, with over 1300 usable stories! We will be meeting soon to go over the data and identify themes. There will be community presentations on our findings in the coming months. There is also a special meeting on 9/14 for voting CAC members to talk about changes within CareOregon.

Board Prep: Our CACs have been invited to attend the CCO Board meeting on September 18. This will be a hybrid meeting, which we will make time to debrief at our October meeting.

IA Update: Belle discussed the 1115 Medicaid Waiver at length. All kids on OHP will automatically be eligible until age 6, and adults will only have to recertify every two years instead of each year.

Community Check-in: People had questions about the recent resurgence of COVID, and discussed other vaccines, such as the RSV vaccine.
