## **Group Agreements:**

The group reviewed the agreements and approved them; we will vote on adopting them into the Charter at our annual business meeting in March 2020.

CCO 2.0 and IA Update: Nancy and Joell presented information about CCO 2.0 and upcoming items; the CACs will be playing a bigger role in the new CCO 2.0. Next March, we will submit an Equity Plan, which will outline the CACs' role. Health related services will be strongly tied into community investments. We are currently reviewing the new guidelines and will be working on this together. In lieu of a December CAC meeting, we will be using that time for 2020 planning and meeting with individual CAC members. Columbia Pacific CCO will be holding a meeting will be held on Thursday, October 24, from 4:30-6pm at the Tillamook OSU Extension Service to present CCO 2.0 work.

**Behavioral Health:** Leslie Ford and Tom Bialozor from Columbia Pacific CCO's behavioral health team presented on the CCO benefits. In June 2019, CPCCO took over the behavioral health benefit, and the primary priority is to ensure continuity of a high level of care for members. There is now a single member services number to call for both physical and behavioral health. They reviewed the different levels of behavioral health and addiction care and answered questions. We asled them to come back in a few months for an update.
